



Requirements for a Florida ID or License

The number on your card is assigned on a first come first served basis and signifies priority at each agency throughout the event. IDignity will only provide one of each document (birth certificate, ID and Social Security card) to each client every four months.

As of Jan. 1st 2010, obtaining a Florida ID or License has become much more difficult.

It is likely you will not qualify to obtain a Florida ID or License today, yet it is important to start the process by completing the IDignity event. Clients that cannot meet the new requirements might be able to apply for consideration of exception.

In order to obtain a Florida ID or License you will need to provide documents from the following three categories. IDignity volunteers will try to assist you in obtaining any missing yet required documentation.

(1) Proof of Identity (need one of the following)

- An original certified birth certificate from Vital Statistics (not from hospital)
- A U.S. passport, permanent resident card or immigration documents.

(2) Documentation of your Social Security Number (need one of the following)

- Social Security card or receipt, Tax receipt, Job payment stub

(3) Proof of Residency (need two from the following)

- Letter from a shelter claiming you as a resident
- Mortgage or rental agreement
- Parent or Legal guardian with proof of residence to accompany applicant
- Tax form (W-2 or 1099) or recent mail from a government agency
- Utility bill or bank statement less than two months old
- Certification of Address form from the Dept. of Motor Vehicles
